**Re: Vacation Care during October 2024 Holidays**

We are looking forward to your children joining us for our October School Holiday Vacation Care program. This Vacation Care program will run from **Monday 30 September – Friday 11 October 2024**. **Please note that we will be closed on Monday 7 October for the Public Holiday.**

Please note that the trip to the Botanic Gardens on Thursday 3 October 2024 and Inflatable World on Friday 11 October 2024 will only be **for school-aged children attending Vacation Care**, however there is the option for your child/ren to stay at Vacation Care at the College. ***There is an extra cost for the Inflatable World excursion.***

When the children are at Vacation Care, we will be separating into the following groups:

<b>Cubs:</b>	Preschool Children	(aged 3-5 years)
<b>Thunder Kids:</b>	School Children	(aged 5-8 years)
<b>Comets:</b>	School Children	(aged 9-16 years)

**Some important reminders when attending Vacation Care:**

- Vacation Care runs between 7:00am and 6:00pm. You can drop off / pick up anywhere between these times (however, please check excursion departure / return times).
- If your family have not accessed OOSH or Vacation Care before, you will need to complete an additional Enrolment Form (Please see the College Office for an Enrolment Form).
- You will need to pack a water bottle (clearly labelled with their name), fruit-o, morning tea and lunch. Please do not pack 2-minute noodles. We are NOT able to heat food for the children. The College canteen will NOT be operating during Vacation Care.
- We are a nut aware service. Please do NOT pack any nut products.
- Appropriate clothing is required. This includes enclosed shoes, covered shoulders and a sun-safe broad brimmed hat.
- We are a child-led service and may therefore adjust activities based upon the interests of the children on the day.

**Synopsis of the movies:**

Summary of the movie: Inside Out

Inside Out is an animated film that follows the inner workings of the mind of a young girl named Riley. Five personified emotions—Joy, Sadness, Anger, Fear, and Disgust—try to lead her through life as she and her parents adjust to their new surroundings after moving from Minnesota to San Francisco.

Summary of the movie: Inside Out 2

Inside Out 2 is a sequel to the original movie. The movie returns to the mind of newly minted teenager Riley just as headquarters is undergoing a sudden demolition to make room for something entirely unexpected: new Emotions! The storyline focuses on the introduction of Anxiety as a new emotion, revealing the struggles associated with adolescence, such as identity, school, and friendships.
