STEP 1. Decide who to talk to. Figure out who's the best person that can give you the help that you need.



STEP 2. Work out

what to say.

Think about what's been bothering you and even write it down so it's clear in your mind.

#### STEP 3. Time it right.



Try to find a time when you can have their undivided attention. It doesn't have to be face-toface; you can call, message, or video chat.

#### STEP 4. How to have

topic, focus on using 'I' statements and be specific. Let the person know if you want advice, practical support or just someone



STEP 5. Don't give up. If you're not getting the support that you need, don't give up. Keep going until you find someone that can help you.
