Please note that the trip to Forum 6 Cinema on Wednesday 17 January 2024 will be **for all school-aged children** attending Vacation Care, however there is the option for your child/ren to stay at Vacation Care at the College. ***There is an extra cost for the excursions.***

When the children are at Vacation Care, we will be separating into the following groups:

Comets:	School Children	(aged 9-16 years)

Some important reminders when attending Vacation Care:

- Vacation Care runs between 7:00am and 6:00pm. You can drop off / pick up anywhere between these times (however, please check excursion departure / return times).
- If your family have not accessed OOSH or Vacation Care before, you will need to complete an additional Enrolment Form (Please see the College Office for an Enrolment Form).
- You will need to pack a water bottle (clearly labelled with their name), fruit-o, morning tea and lunch. Please do not pack 2-minute noodles. We are NOT able to heat food for the children. The College canteen will NOT be operating during Vacation Care.
- We are a nut aware service. Please do NOT pack any nut products.
- Appropriate clothing is required. This includes enclosed shoes, covered shoulders and a sun-safe broad brimmed hat.
- We are a child-led service and may therefore adjust activities based upon the interests of the children on the day.
